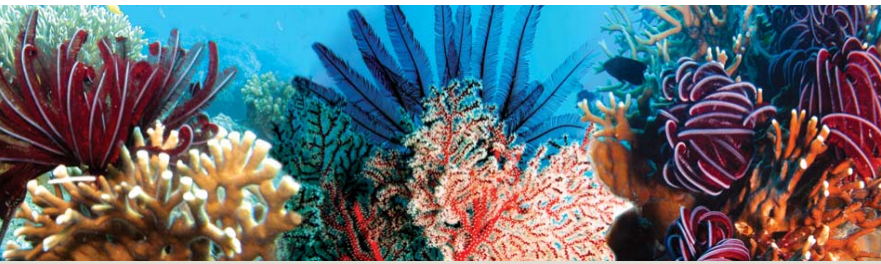
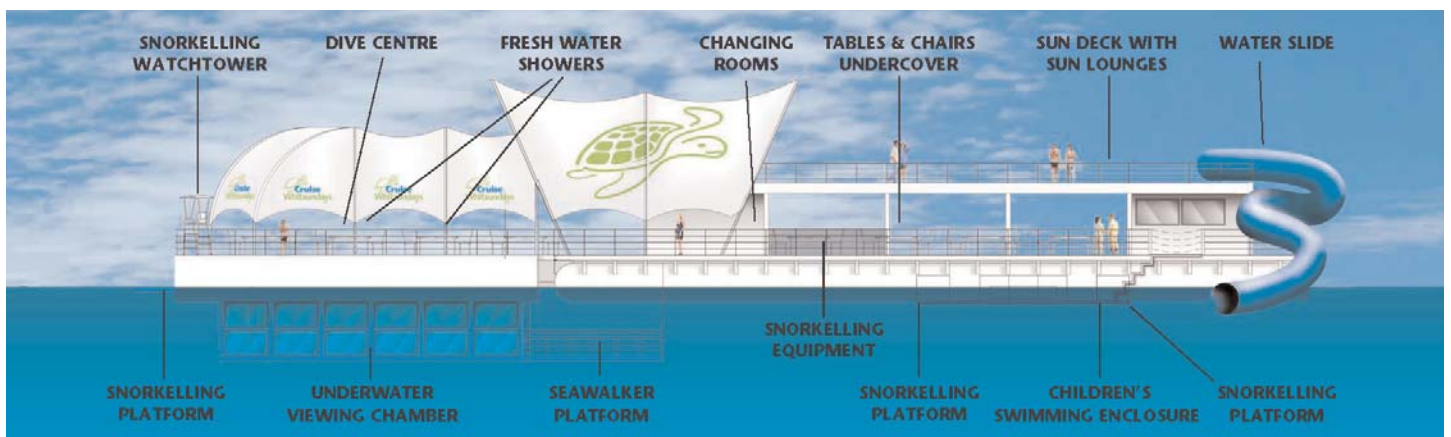


# Reef adventure

## 'SEAFLIGHT'

Getting to Knuckle Reef lagoon is half the fun on board 'Seaflight', a 37-metre wave piercer ideally suited to Outer Reef cruising with its superior sea handling. It is currently the largest vessel in the Whitsundays and is fitted with a motion control system. 'Seaflight' has spacious air-conditioned lounges, large viewing decks and two bars.

## PONTOON

The pontoon boasts the most innovative design. It is spacious with a choice of areas for chilling out and enjoying a wonderful array of activities. There is undercover seating and tables, plus sun decks for topping up the tan, freshwater showers and change rooms. The pontoon features a spectacular underwater viewing chamber where you'll feel like you are in the water with the fish, plus a fun giant water slide. There is also a swimming enclosure for children. And, you'll also still have full access to the air-conditioned comfort of 'Seaflight' alongside the pontoon. Situated inside Knuckle Reef lagoon, the pontoon is ideally located in shallower waters than you'll find in most other parts, with protection from surrounding sea conditions. The lagoon has its own ecosystem with magnificent corals and marine life not found in more open areas. It provides a unique world

for you to explore - be it a 'Subsea' adventure in a semi submersible or by glass bottom boat snorkelling or diving.
